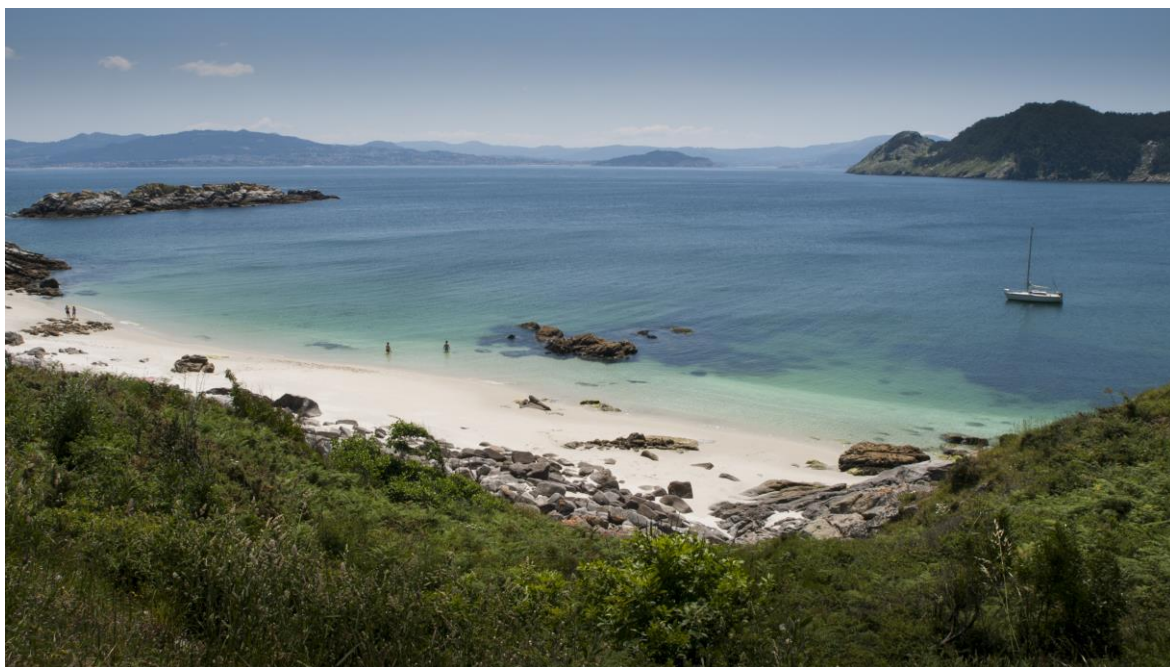


Rodas Beach

The most visited beach in Galicia became world-famous when **The Guardian** named it “the best beach in the world” in 2007. The prestigious British newspaper described it as an authentic “Caribbean beach” and “the water is turquoise enough, the sand white enough to believe the comparison...” and those who visit the beach can easily see why.

The coves of **Viños or Bolos, Areíña and Area Grande de Muxieiro**—a natural extension of Rodas—make the beach even more spectacular. Boasting a Blue Flag, its characteristics and services make the perfect spot to spend a day out with the family on the beach.





More beaches

Besides Rodas, the Islands also boast other delightful beaches with crystal-clear waters:

- **Figueiras:** also known as the “Germans’ beach”, it’s a blue flag beach that's a great favourite among nudists.
- **Nosa Señora:** a small beach with peaceful waters perfect for diving.
- **A Cantareira and Margaridas coves:** exclusive spots for those looking for some peace and quiet and being in contact with nature.
- **San Martiño:** located on the South Island, it’s a more pristine beach only reachable by private boat.

Monte Faro

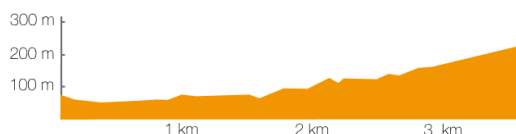
Enjoy the spectacular panoramic views from the two lookout points.

Points of interest: Rodas Beach and dunes - Lagoa dos nenos - Pedra da Campá - Cíes Lighthouse

Distance: 7.4 km (round trip)

Travel Time: 2 h 30 min (round trip)

Difficulty: moderate



Faro da Porta

Enjoy the best views of the South Island.

Points of interest: Rodas Beach and dunes - Lagoa dos nenos - Playa de Nosa Señora - A Porta Lighthouse - Castro das Hortas.

Distance: 5.2 km (round trip)

Travel Time: 1 h 45 min (round trip)

Difficulty: low

Alto do Príncipe

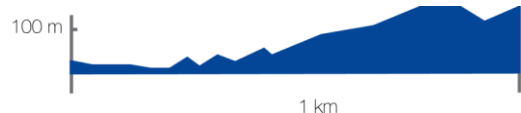
Discover the contrast between the two sides of the island from the lookout point you will arrive at after a short trek in the shade.

Distance: 3 km (round trip)

Monteagudo

From O Peito Lighthouse you have spectacular views: Cabo Home, Monte Facho, Costa da Vela and the Ons archipelago.

Points of interest: Figueira-Muxieiro dune complex - Figueiras Beach - Bird Observatory - O Peito Lighthouse - Furna de Monteagudo.

Distance: 5.6 km (round trip).

Travel Time: 1 h 45 min (round trip)

Difficulty: low

The Cíes archipelago is one of the fourteen places around the world with the “Starlight Tourist Destination” certificate. It’s a recognition for locations with excellent stargazing conditions, with night skies completely free of light pollution. Mar de Ons organises activities such as night tours, the observation of phenomena such as the **Tears of St Lawrence** from an anchored vessel, etc.

Nature reserve

The Cíes Islands have been part of the Atlantic Islands of Galicia Marine-Terrestrial National Park since 2002. It's a highly protected area that is only accessible by boat and has a limited number of daily visits. In order to preserve the environment and keep it a paradise accessible to everyone, here is a list of basic rules that must be followed.



Do not disturb the wildlife. Pets are not allowed (except for guide dogs).



There are no rubbish bins, so bring your rubbish back to the port of origin. Do not take anything else with you, and leave the park as you found it. You are not allowed to take shells from the beach or pick flowers or fruits.



Respect protected and restricted areas (lake, cliffs, dunes, etc.). Bicycles are not allowed.



You can only camp out at the campsite. To prevent fires, do not light fires. Avoid making loud noises to preserve the tranquillity of the island.

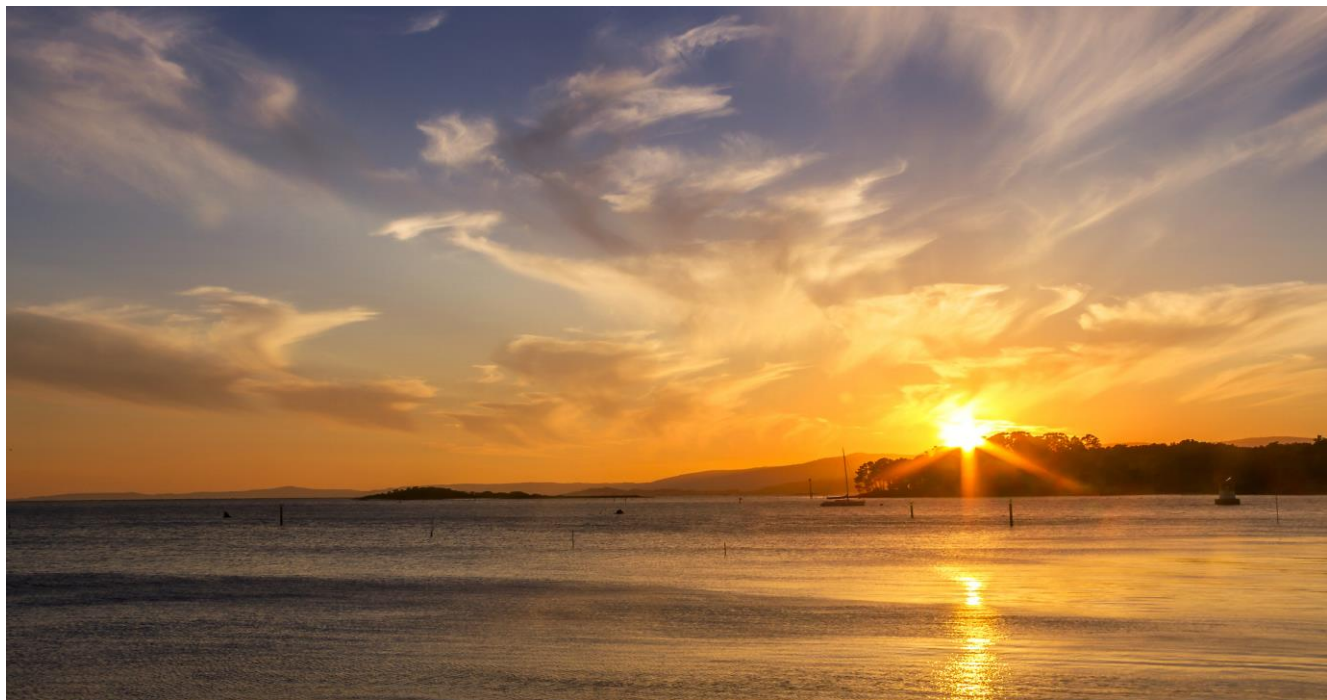

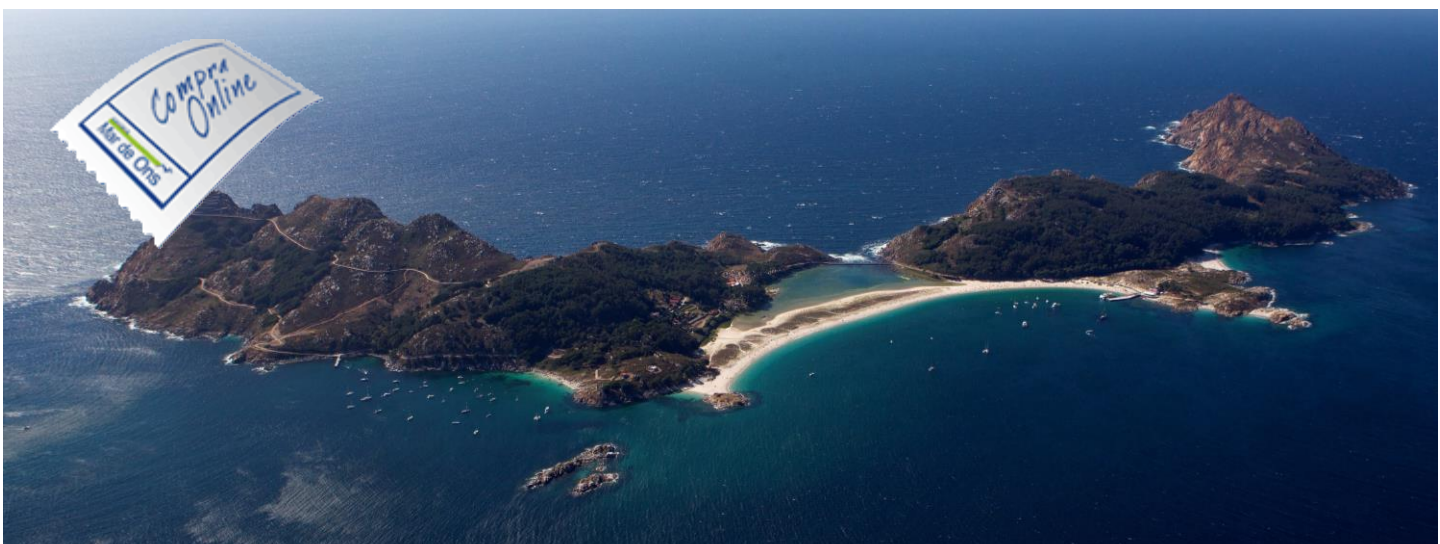
