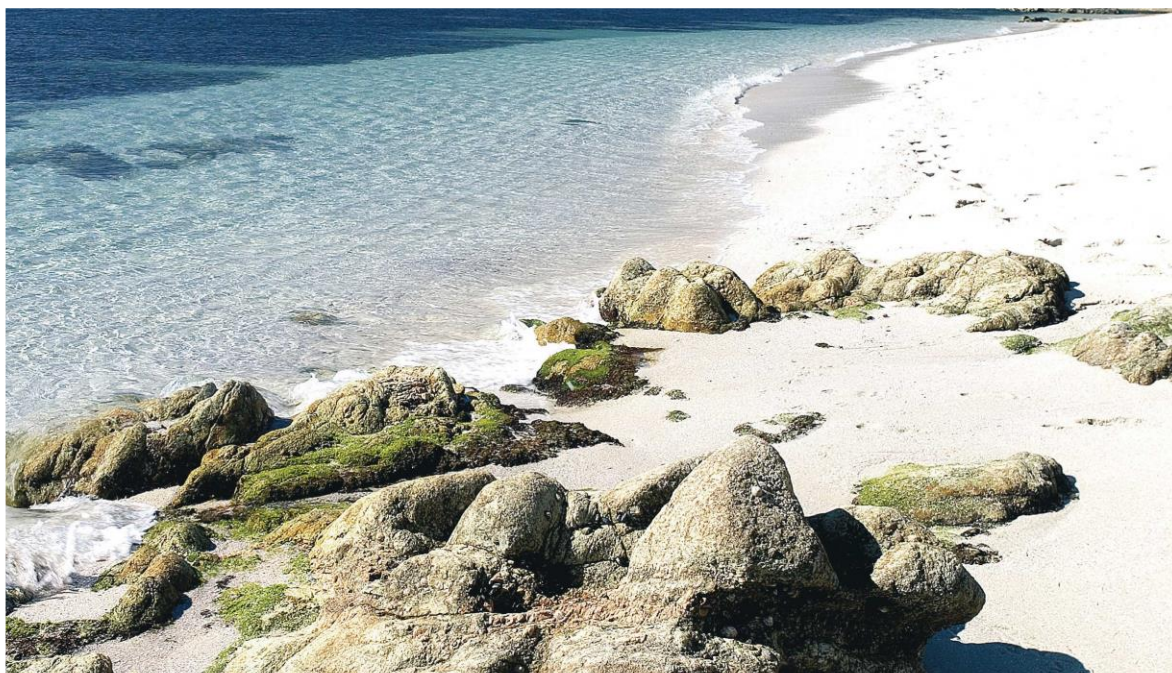

It belongs to the Atlantic Islands of Galicia Marine-Terrestrial National Park and you will be able to enjoy it with your five senses. If you want to continue sparking them, enrich your experience by relaxing and enjoying the sun at one of these pristine beaches:

Melide, the perfect beach to walk barefoot by the seashore, as you enjoy the feeling of cool sand between your toes.

Area dos Cans, where you can dive into the invigorating waters of the Atlantic Ocean.

Canexol, the best choice for a day out in the sun as you revel in the texture of its fine, powdery white sand.

Pereiró, where you can be the first to leave your mark while the sea breeze gently caresses your face.

Castelo Trail

The sea shaping the coastline, the gentle gurgling of the Fonte do Castelo and the breeze blowing through the willows will join you along the way.

Points of interest: Ruínas do Castelo - Fonte do Castelo.

Distance: 1.1 km.

Travel Time: 40 min.

Difficulty: low



Southern Trail

The deep roar of the Atlantic Ocean whose waves continuously crash in the background of Buraco do Inferno is unforgettable.

Points of interest: Area dos Cans Beach - Canexol Beach - Fedorentos Lookout Point - Buraco do Inferno.

Distance: 6.2 km.

Travel Time: 2h 30 min.

Difficulty: moderate.

Northern Trail

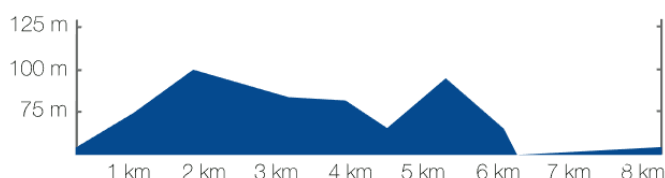
From the Punta Centolo lookout point, you can see Sálvora, Arousa, A Lanzada, O Grove, Costa da Vela...

Points of interest: Enseada de Caniveliñas - Punta Uñeros - Ons Lighthouse - Punta Centolo - Melide Beach.

Distance: 8.1 km.

Travel Time: 3h.

Difficulty: moderate.



Lighthouse Trail

Enjoy breathtaking panoramic views from the highest point on the island.

Points of interest: Enseada de Caniveliñas - Ons Lighthouse.

Distance: 4 km.

Travel Time: 1h 15 min.

Difficulty: low.

Nature

The fragrance of local flowers and the distinctive scent of the ocean will envelop you during your stay on the Ons archipelago. Enjoy nature at its purest in this stunning setting, which has been part of the Atlantic Islands of Galicia Marine-Terrestrial National Park since 2002. It's a highly protected area that is only accessible by boat. To preserve it, here are some basic rules that must be followed.



Do not disturb the wildlife. Pets are not allowed (except for guide dogs).



There are no rubbish bins, so bring your rubbish back to the port of origin. Do not take anything else with you, and leave the park as you found it. You are not allowed to take shells from the beach or pick flowers or fruits.



Respect protected and restricted areas (lake, cliffs, dunes, etc.). Bicycles are not allowed.



To prevent fires, do not light fires. Avoid making loud noises to preserve the tranquillity of the island.

Octopus

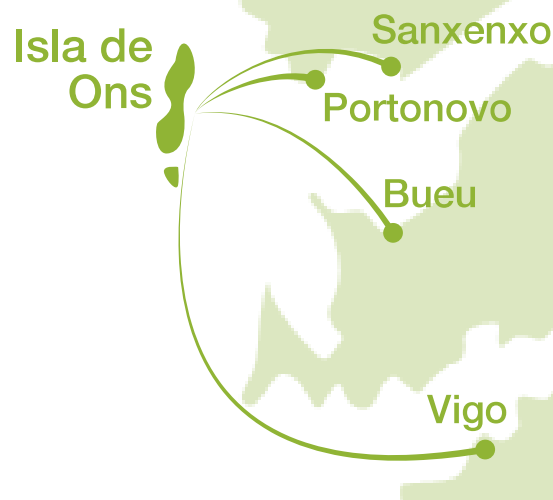
