## History of ría de Vigo

#### **Learn About The Battle of Rande**

The Battle of Rande is the most important historical event that happened on the ría de Vigo. It took place on 23 October 1702 between the Anglo-Dutch and Spanish-French coalitions, during the War of the Spanish Succession.

Legend has it that the battle was so fierce that the Count of Château-Renault, who led the defence of the Spanish convoy, made the decision to throw all the merchandise into the water before they could fall into the hands of the enemy. And since then, thousands of expeditions, adventurers, scientists and the inquisitive have tried—without success—to find the greatest treasure from America ever known: gold, silver, jewellery, etc. A valuable booty that remains in the depths of the estuary... Care you join us to try to find it?
